2022-2023 Grade 11 Course Selection Guidelines

Please note that these guidelines are for **current Grade 10 students in mainstream classes** at Kenner CVI. International Baccalaureate students will be provided with IB specific guidelines to ensure that their course selections meet IB programme requirements.

1. All students must register for EIGHT (8) courses plus an alternate course.
2. All students must take the following TWO (2) compulsory credits within your current Grade 10 Level of Study: Academic, Applied, and/or Locally Developed.
